

The president of the provincial court of Guadalajara is the representative figure of the judicial institution in the province. The president is appointed by the General Council of the Judiciary for a term of five years, with the possibility of re-election. The president combines governmental and representative tasks of the post with the presidency of one section of the court.

The president of the provincial court of Guadalajara is magistrate Isabel Serrano Frías.

Born in 1964 in Madrid. After earning a law degree from the Universidad Autónoma de Madrid, she acceded to the judicial profession after sitting a competitive examination in 1989. She served as a judge in the district court (subsequently court of first instance) of Novelda (Alicante) and later in the court of first instance of Alcorcón (Madrid).

In 1990, she rose to the rank of magistrate, taking charge of the 1st employment tribunal of Viscera. In 1992, she arrived to the provincial court of Guadalajara, of which she has been and is a magistrate.

Since 2009, she has presided over the provincial court of Guadalajara.
