

The president of the provincial court of Guadalajara is the representative figure of the judicial institution in the province. The president is appointed by the General Council of the Judiciary for a term of five years, with the possibility of re-election. The president combines governmental and representative tasks of the post with the presidency of one section of the court.

The president of the provincial court of Toledo is magistrate Manuel Gutiérrez Sánchez-Caro.

Born in Toledo in 1947. Entered the judicial profession in 1976 and has served as a judge in the court of first instance of Jerez de los Caballeros (Badajoz), the district court of Villarrobledo, the district court and subsequent 1st court of first instance of Orgaz (Toledo), and the 1st district court of Toledo.

In 1987, he rose to the rank of magistrate. He served on the 2nd Parole Board court of Barcelona. In 1988, he held the post of magistrate of the provincial court of Toledo, a bench of judges on which he has served ever since and of which he has acted as president since 2004.
