As part of its policy of transparency, the General Council of the Judiciary (GCJ), has taken, for the tenth time, the step of compiling “The Justice System: all the facts”, which sets out the key statistics for 2012 relating to the various elements making up the Spanish court system, including several comparisons with data compiled in the years before. It is elaborated to show a general view over the complex activity of the judiciary.





**Percentage of coverage by non-permanent staff (PCNP):** The total number of days in which positions of a particular category have been occupied by non-permanent staff members, divided by the number of staff members in that category multiplied by 365. This is expressed as a percentage.

**Percentage of non-covered days (PNCD):** The total number of days in which positions of a particular category have been left uncovered, divided by the number of staff members in that category multiplied by 365. This is expressed as a percentage.

**Rotation index (RI):** Number of investitures both of permanent positions and others, divided by the organic staff in the category. This is a measurement of the stability of the staff.





Judicial Statistics: set down, disposed of and pending proceedings at the end of every period of time. It offers an estimation of the average length of the cases ended in each period. **The lengths are stated in months**
