



This is expressed as a percentage.

Percentage of non-covered days (PNCD): Relationships between the number of days in which positions of a concrete professional status have been uncovered, and the number of those professional status members, multiplied by 365. This is expressed as a percentage.

Rotation index (RI): Relationships between the number of investitures both of permanent positions and others, and the staff allocated for that professional status. This is a measurement of the stability of the staff.


